### Making Materials

2. To make online flashcards, there are lots of options but a lot of them charge. Perhaps not the most exciting (but at least free and very easy!) website for this is [www.scholastic.com/kids/homework/flashcards.htm](http://www.scholastic.com/kids/homework/flashcards.htm) . It is an American site but it is very easy to input the words and then use them. Students can be encouraged to be resourceful themselves and might come up with different options. They could be encouraged to share their 'find' with the rest of the class too.

### Using PowerPoint

1. PowerPoint can also be used for flashcards of a sort if you think about it. (see the document Electronic Flashcards in your file) Students can do this instead of the teachers obviously.
2. Making 'books' in PowerPoint is also something that students can do for younger students. If you have good links with your primary schools then they could find a very willing 'audience' there.
